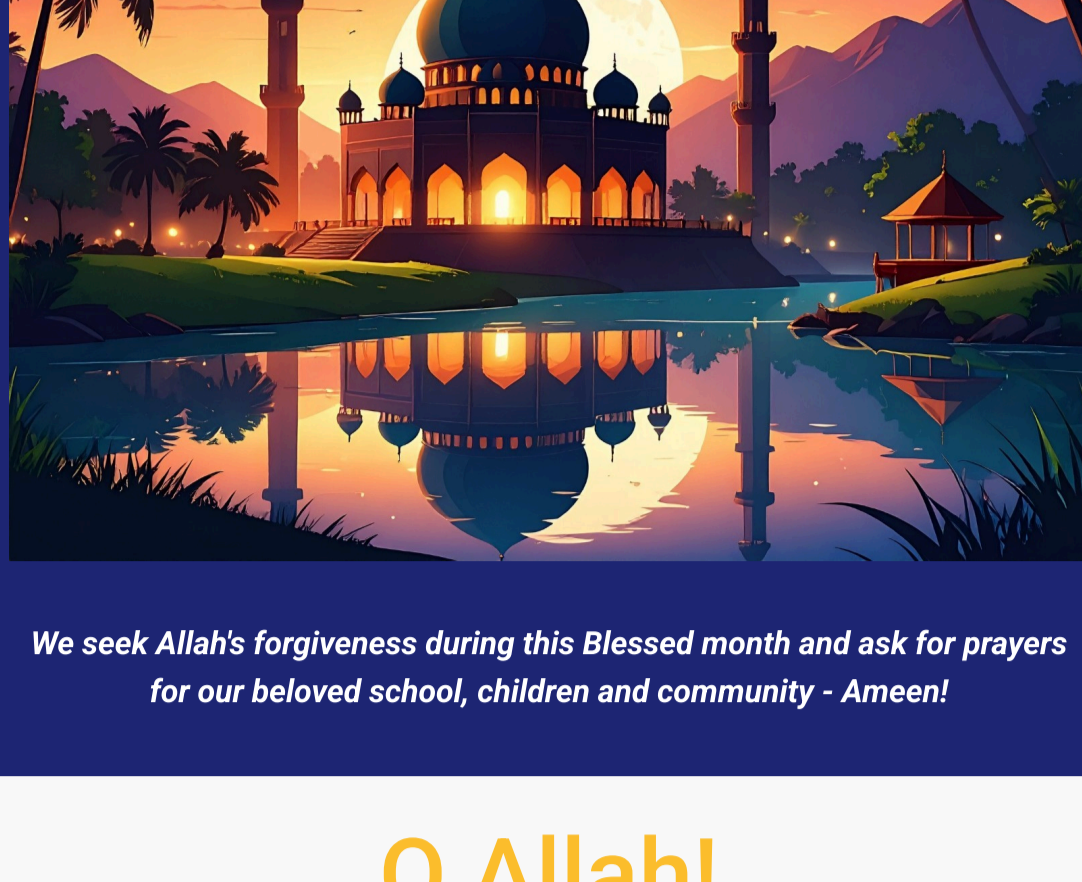


Welcome to the Special Edit Newsletter

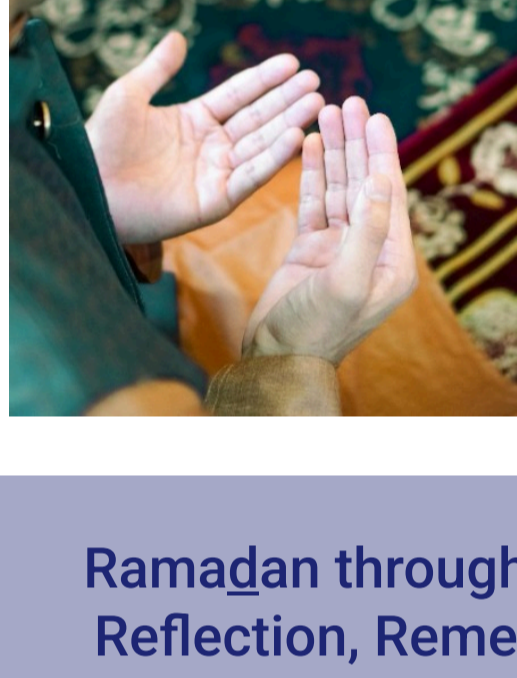
The Night of al-Qadr

"O Allah, it is for You I have fasted and with the sustenance You gave me I have broken my fast."

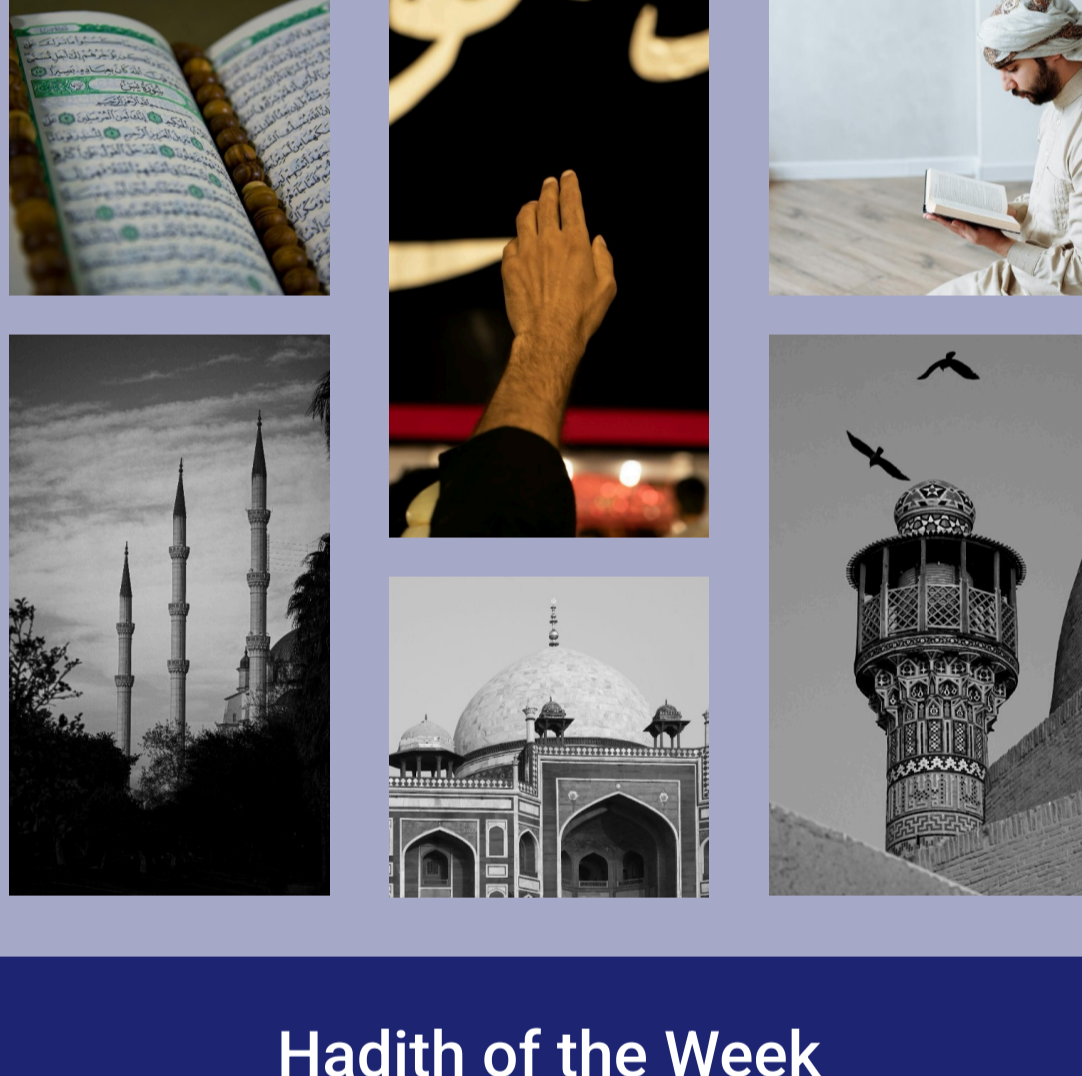

Hadeeth

أَلَا إِنَّ فِي الْجَسَدِ مُضْغَةً، إِذَا صَلَحَتْ صَلَحَ الْجَسَدُ كُلُّهُ، وَإِذَا فَسَدَتْ فَسَدَ الْجَسَدُ كُلُّهُ، أَلَا وَهِيَ الْقَلْبُ

'Alaa inna fil-jasadi mudghah, idhaa salahat salahal-jasadu kulluh, wa 'idhaa fasadat fasadal-jasadu kulluh, 'alaa wa hiyal-qalb
